Workshop Information

- Workshops will run for a 2 week time period, every other day.
- Each workshop will run approximately 2 hours per session and offer a variety of activities related to the theme.
- Sessions will run in the morning between the hours of 9am-11:30am.
- Children will be scheduled in 1 workshop per 2 week session, stated below.
- Children will be placed in the workshops with consideration to age, interest and availability of slots. If the number 1 choice is full, the child will be placed in the next choice and so on.
- In order to comply with child care regulations, to meet best practice and to provide a meaningful opportunity for children, workshop slots will be limited with the maximum of 20 slots per workshop. The maximum enrollment per workshop may be less depending on the activities offered.
- In addition to workshops, children will be offered a wide variety of activities in their group setting.
